## **Breakfast and Afterschool Club**



















#### Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is held in the school hall every morning. The main reception door opens at 7:45am until 8:45am. The children are given the opportunity to have breakfast (open until 8:15am only). Breakfast includes: toast with a variety of toppings, cereal, fruit and

yogurts. We ensure that this breakfast is healthy so that children are energised for the school day.

The children can choose from a range of fun, creative activities and are able to free- flow between these. Children are also offered the opportunity to do their homework or some reading if they would like to.

When Breakfast Club finishes at 8:45am the children are then walked to their classrooms in time for school to start.



#### After School Club

After school club runs from 3.15pm until 5.30pm. Key stage One children are collected by a member of Boomerang Club staff and then they are taken to the hall to be signed in. We then either

adventure down to the playground for a variety of activities or if the weather isn't appropriate we go to the library. Children are then offered a snack of bread or fruit and a drink.

We do ask that the children bring:

- A water bottle
- Coat
- A change of clothes

In warmer weather we ask that they also bring:

- Sun cream
- Sun Hat

After school club is a free-flow system where

children can choose what they would like to play with. Some of the activities available are: art and crafts, colouring, reading, drawing, construction, board games, bikes and trikes. We also offer the opportunity for children to do their homework. We like to spend lots of time outside using the

playground, garden and woodlands.

On pick up we ask that parents sign their children out, a member of staff will approach you and show you where to sign.

#### **Extra Information**

A booking form is sent out at the

beginning of each week for the following weeks wraparound provision. This form closes at 12pm on the Thursday. Please be aware that we cannot take any

bookings after this time. Please ensure your child is aware that they will be

attending. If you do not require your child to attend on a booked day please

telephone the office and inform them that you do not need wraparound. If you do not inform the office and your child does not attend you will be charged. For breakfast club, please come to the main reception door.

Afterschool Club is normally based on the playground/garden furthest away from the main gate, weather permitting. If we are not on the playground we will be in the computer suite, next to the school hall or in the hall.
