Free Fruit / Breaktime Snacks

Nursery, Foundation and years 1 and 2 receive free fruit at school, this provided through the government funded 'School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme', children are able to select a piece of fresh fruit at morning break time. Your child is able to bring a snack from home if they would prefer, however we ask that it is a healthy bread-based or fruit snack.

Stars and Sunbeams have free fruit and milk (if under 5 years old) from the schemes in the morning and we allow them to bring their own snack for the afternoon if they wish

to do so. This is because many of our younger ones get so hungry after our outdoor learning.

Year 1 and 2 have a snack in a morning; they also encourage all children to take a piece of free fruit.

Years 3 - 6 are encouraged to bring in a healthy bread or fruit based snack, alternatively children can buy freshly baked bread or fruit from our kitchen at breaktimes at a cost of £30p per day.

Please can we remind you to send your child to school each day with a water bottle.

Swimming News

This week and next week our swimmers will be learning some new life saving water skills during their swimming lesson.

The aim is to give all children a basic understanding of how they can self rescue, from the youngest age group; by rolling over from their front to their back and floating to our older swimmers who are developing life saving swimming strokes, poolside rescues and towing techniques.

All of the swimmers have a clear understanding that these life saving techniques have the over riding principles of staying safe, not putting yourself in danger and our moto 'throw a float'.
