Further to my communication at the beginning of the week, I am writing to inform you that due to industrial action by the NEU who are in dispute around the continued challenges of under-funding that are putting enormous pressure on school budgets, our school and nursery will be **closed on Wednesday 1st February**.

With the information provided our risk assessment concluded that it would not be operationally safe to open. I am aware this will cause disruption and difficulties for many of you but I have given very careful consideration to this decision, operating normally is not possible on this occasion.
