We examined prehistoric pottery which has been discovered in our local area and, in particular, Gabbroic pots and clay which only comes from The Lizard. The children then had the fantastic and rare opportunity to make individual pots with Gabbroic clay, larger vessels as groups and to try their hands on the potter's wheel; all of which was underlined with local geography and an understanding of human prehistory. A big thank you to CAST and all of the children, who behaved wonderfully and thoroughly embraced the experience.
