MATHS' WEEKS


Mathematics is an incredibly important subject which we use in all walks of life. Studying mathematics stimulates curiosity, fosters creativity and equips children with the skills they need in life beyond school.

Children are able to make better sense of the world around them as we use real world contexts when teaching. The aim is that this should make the subject more accessible, engaging and relevant to real life.

This maths culture at Parc Eglos extends beyond the classroom and can be seen, for example, in our 'maths' weeks'. These weeks are an important way for our children to enjoy and be creative with maths. Some of our focuses have been: Story Maths, Maths Magic and Outdoor Maths. This autumn, we are excited to introduce Cornish Maths, where we will learn about Maths in our local area and take advantage of the learning opportunity that Cornwall has to offer.

Every class (including Nursery) has a floor book which documents the learning during maths week. These can be seen on display in the Year 3/4 corridor.
