




Parc Eglos School World book Week

Nursery News

This week a dental nurse visited the nursery to talk to the children all about their teeth and how to look after them. Amanda talked to the children about her job and asked the children if they had been to the dentist before, some of the children then shared their experiences. Amanda spoke to the children about the drinks that are good for their teeth, like water and milk and drinks that they could have sometimes with a meal like squash. We then spoke about having sweets and


