Dear Parents/ Carers,

Earlier this week, you will have received a letter regarding applying for Free School Meals. The funding for these meals is about to change, therefore if you believe that your children might be eligible, please do complete this simple form (5 mins at the most) to apply. <u>Cornwall Council Website</u>. If you think you child may be entitled to free school meals <u>and apply before 1st April</u>, your child will retain that eligibility to the end of their time at primary school. Any applications from $1^{\rm st}$ April 2025 will be subject to ongoing checks.
