

READING

- Just like in Year 4, children will have a reading book based on their zone of proximal development.
- Children will be assessed half termly in school using the AR algorithm to establish their reading range.
- The login details for your child will remain the same as last year.





Extras to help your child:



- Each Monday children are introduced to their new spelling rule.
 This includes a list of 10 words. Games and activities to
 practise these can be found on EdShed (logins remain the
 same as in Year 4).
- Children have 3 sessions in school learning the spelling rule for the week and practising related activities, such as putting the word into sentences or breaking it into syllables.
- Every Friday children will practise spelling the common exception words.

Extras to help your child - Maths:





We recommend 3 gems per week – log ins remain the same as Year 4.

Great for developing confident fast recall of multiplication and division – logins remain the same.
