
## Spellings



- Every week, children will be introduced to new spellings. Children will then practise these
  for the rest of that week but there is no actual test every week.
- Children can access these spellings through games at home on their devices using the Spelling Shed app.
- Your child has an individual login. This will be sent home ASAP

#### READING

- Children will have access to an accelerated reader book or they can borrow from our class library and change as they wish. We will check their choices to ensure they are suitable.
- Children are able to complete their quiz in school and at home on the AR site.
- Children will be assessed half termly using the AR algorithm to establish their ZPD reading range.



### Homework

- The minimum amount of homework expected at Parc Eglos is daily reading.
- We no longer have diaries but will be checking in regularly to ensure that reading is happening and at what pace children are completing their books
- We also encourage playing the games on Spelling Shed, achieving 3 gems on Maths Whizz and regular TTRS.
- In Y6, we also send home maths arithmetic homework after Christmas.
   This will be accompanied with a parent help booklet so you can see our strategies and help if needed.
