Dear Parents and Carers,

We're pleased to offer your child the opportunity to attend a Year 3 school trip to the Royal Cornwall Museum on Wednesday 3rd December. This all-day visit will support our History unit on the Stone Age to Iron Age and promises to be a fun and educational experience. Activities will include a hands-on workshop linked to our History curriculum, handling real-life artefacts from the Stone Age to Iron Age as well as time to explore the museum's exhibits.

The trip will take place during school hours therefore your child's annual consent covers permission for this trip. If you would not like your child to attend, please speak to your class teacher. To help to cover the cost of the workshop and transport, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.45 per child, which can be payable through ParentPay.

Your child will need to wear school uniform as normal for the day and bring a packed lunch and water bottle with them. If your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them.
