Dear Year 1 Parents and Carers,

As we come to the end of our Science unit on Animals, including humans, we are excited to share that the children will be taking part in a special Enrichment Activity focusing on the five senses.

This activity will help the children explore what our senses are, how they work, and why they are important for both animals and humans. To make this learning hands-on and engaging, the children will be examining and tasting a selection of food items.

They will:

- Look closely at the food item
- Predict the type of taste they expect
- Taste the food
- Decide what taste they experienced
- Compare their answers with their classmates

The foods being tried are: **lemon, dark chocolate, tomato, strawberry, and chopped preserved olive.**

If you do not wish for your child to handle or taste these foods, please make your child's teacher aware.

For children with known dairy allergies, a non-dairy chocolate alternative will be provided.

We are looking forward to this exciting activity, which will give the children a memorable way to consolidate their learning about senses.
