<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sun cream and sun hat</li> <li>• Snack for coach trip</li> <li>• Full water bottle (water only please)</li> <li>• Packed lunch - no fizzy drinks.</li> <li>• A raincoat for unexpected showers</li> <li>• Children may bring something to play with on the coach (not electronics or phones) e.g. teddy, card game, reading book, drawing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sleeping bag</li> <li>• Pillow</li> <li>• Camping mat</li> <li>• Clothes to sleep in - e.g. pjs, jogging bottoms, shorts (not nightdresses please)</li> <li>• Toiletries - toothbrush, toothpaste, 2 face cloths/flannels (one for wet, one to dry), hairbrush</li> <li>• Underwear and a change of clothes for the next day.</li> <li>• A book</li> <li>• Torch</li> <li>• A midnight snack - NO NUTS OR SWEETS</li> <li>• Teddy/comforter (if required)</li> </ul>

### **TO GIVE TO YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER**

- Any medication must be clearly labelled and in a named plastic bag with the medication form detailing doses etc. (Available from the school office).
- Travel sickness medication to be given by parents before they leave. For the return journey, it must be clearly labelled and in a named plastic bag with the medication form enclosed.
- Spending money (maximum of £10) in a named wallet or sealed plastic/sandwich bag.
