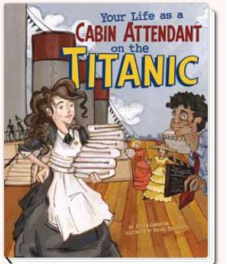
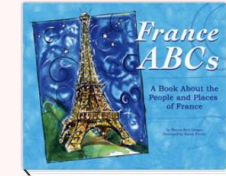

Research consistently shows that **little and often** is the most effective approach. Establishing regular routines at home helps children to develop positive learning habits and gives them the best opportunity to succeed. Even a few minutes each day can have a significant impact over time.

Library

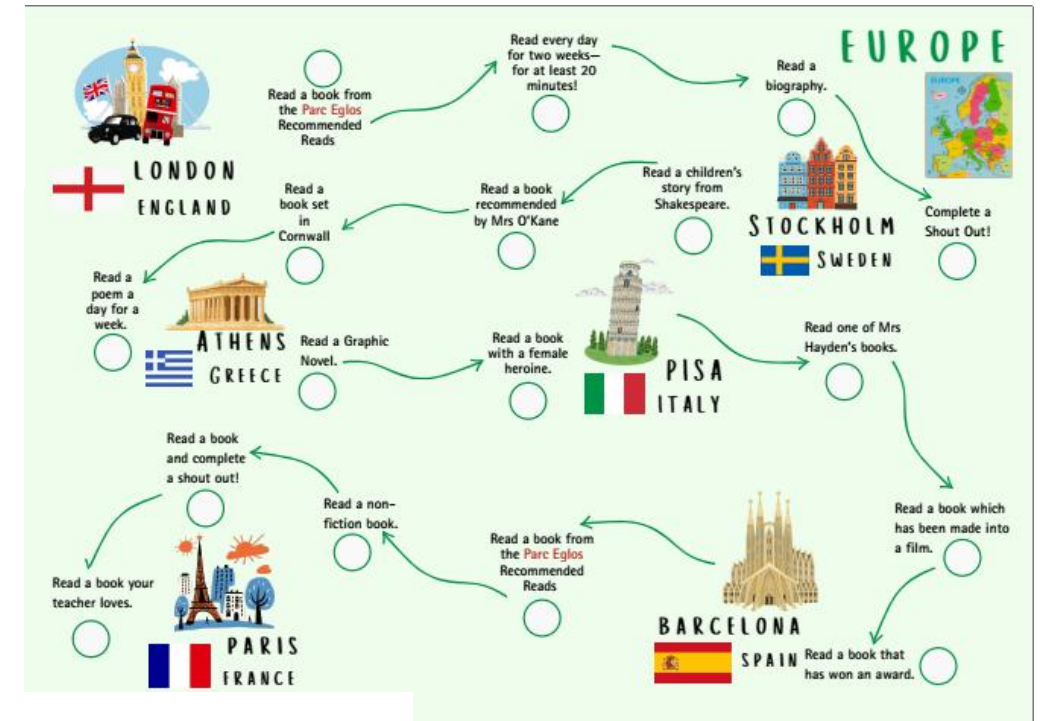


We visit the library each Wednesday afternoon for half an hour.

Reading Journals

Children will record their progress throughout their journey in their **Parc Eglos Reading Journey Log Book**. These will remain in school.



These journals will allow teachers to:

- Support purposeful **'book talk'** between teachers and pupils
- Track which children may need additional support to read regularly
- Monitor reading engagement and progress
- Share information with you about your child's reading journey and reading diet, allowing us to work in partnership with families to celebrate successes and develop strategies that encourage a lifelong love of reading.

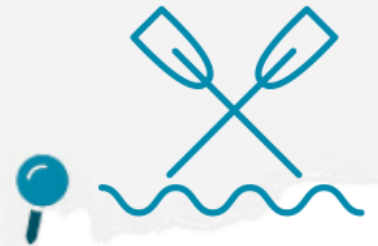
